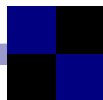

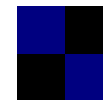

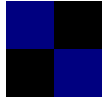

## The Link Between Preschool Options and the IEP

**Workshop Summary:** Participants will be able to use the IEP Team Process to:

- Determine the Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) for **each child** with a disability.

**Information Update Bulletin 08.05 and how to provide FAPE-Free Appropriate Public Education in the Least Restrictive Environment will be addressed.**

- Develop a present level of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance
- Write functional goals and objectives based on the child's needs as stated in the present level.
- Implement Special Education Services that address the child's educational goals and considers the general education curriculum and general education environment.

Participants will:

- Use a sample IEP (bring an IEP without child's name and identifying information) to practice writing the present level, functional goals, and special education services.
- Learn about a range of Preschool Options (environments) that could be considered as the LRE based on each child's goals and objectives.
- Hear about and view examples of Preschool Options in other Wisconsin communities.
- Develop an Action Plan for considering LRE for children with disabilities in their community.
