Workshop Summary

Participants will be able to use the IEP Team Process to:

- Determine the Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) for each child with a disability.
- Develop a present level of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance (including student's strengths and the concerns of the parents about the student's education).
- Develop functional goals and objectives based on the child's needs related to his/her disability as stated in the present level.
- Develop Special Education Services that address the child's educational goals and considers Least Restrictive Environment (general education curriculum and general education environment).

Participants will:

- Use a sample IEP (bring an IEP without child's name and identifying information) to practice writing the present level, functional goals and special education services.
- Learn about a range of Preschool Options (environments) that could be considered as the LRE based on each child's goals and objectives.
- Hear about and view examples of Preschool Options in other Wisconsin communities.
- Develop an Action Plan for considering LRE for children with disabilities in their community.

Target Audience

Birth to 3, 4K Teachers, ECSE Teachers, School Psychologists, OT / PT, Speech / Language Pathologists, Child Care and Head Start Teachers, Elementary Principals, Special Education / Pupil Services Directors. Teams are highly encouraged. It is recommended that teams include a child care partner and principal or director.
